

AGREEMENT

BETWEEN: WINNIPEG AREA CONTROL CENTRE (ACC) and WINNIPEG GLIDING CLUB

EFFECTIVE: April 15, 2019 @ 0901UTC.

SUBJECT: AIR TRAFFIC CONTROL AND COORDINATION PROCEDURES

CANCELS: AGREEMENT BETWEEN WINNIPEG ACC AND WINNIPEG GLIDING CLUB dated May 1, 2015.

A. PURPOSE

A.1 The purpose of this Agreement is to establish procedures between Winnipeg Area Control Centre (ACC) and the Winnipeg Gliding Club for soaring activities within the airspace above CYA408(S), and as defined in this Agreement as the Winnipeg Gliding Club Soaring Extensions A and B.

B. RESPONSIBILITIES

WINNIPEG GLIDING CLUB

- B.1
- a. Notify the ACC at least 30 minutes prior to requiring activation of the airspace above CYA408(S) or Extension A and/or B.
 - b. Advise the ACC when the airspace above CYA408(S) or Extension A and/or B are no longer required as soon as possible.
- B.2 Shall establish procedures for the recall of their gliders from the airspace above CYA408(S) or Extension A and/or B if the airspace is required by the ACC.
- B.3 When conducting ongoing glider operations at any other airport listed in the CFS, an advisory NOTAM will be filed with the Winnipeg FIC by the Winnipeg Gliding Club informing local customers of glider activity.

ACC

- B.4 The ACC will ensure that all known IFR traffic will remain clear of the airspace above CYA408(S) and Extension A and/or B (as described in paragraph C.3) when the airspace is active.
- B.5 Is responsible for approving or denying flight 3,000ft ASL and above within Soaring Area Extensions.

C. DESCRIPTION OF AIRSPACE

- C.1 Winnipeg Gliding Club Soaring Area CYA408(S) as defined in the Designated Airspace Handbook TP1820E.
- C.2 The Winnipeg Terminal Control Area (TCA) are as defined in the Designated Airspace Handbook TP1820E.
- C.3 Winnipeg Gliding Club Soaring Area Extensions A and B, as defined and depicted in Attachment A.
- C.4 Winnipeg Gliding Club Main Area Extension airspace directly above and contained within the lateral confines of CYA408(S).

D. PROCEDURES

D.1 SOARING AREA EXTENSIONS

- D.1.1 A Winnipeg Gliding Club representative will request through the ACC Duty Shift Manager (204 983-8338 primary), (secondary - via air/ground radio communication with the ACC Terminal Controller on frequency 121.0 MHz), the use of the Main Area Extension, Extension A and/or B including the highest altitude and time period required.
- D.1.2 At times when only the Main Area Extension is required, it will be activated separately. When Extension A is activated, it will include the airspace above CYA408(S). Extension A and B may be activated with ACC approval separately or combined.
- D.1.3 Requested altitudes can be to a maximum of 8000 ASL, 12,500 ASL on weekends and statutory holidays, and should be in 1,000ft. increments. Altitude approval will be based on traffic and other operational conditions.
- D.1.4 The same procedure of notification as specified in paragraph D.1.1 will be followed in advising the ACC, when Soaring Area Extensions are no longer required.
- D.1.5 If required, the ACC will cancel or revise Soaring Area Extensions via:
(order of priority)
 - a. Winnipeg Gliding Clubhouse 204 735-2868, or
 - b. Call to "any glider" on frequency 123.4.
 - c. Call the cell phone provided by the Gliding Club Duty Instructor or Field Manager.
- D.1.6 The ACC will give as much notice as possible when intending to cancel or revise any Soaring Area Extension.

D.2 REVIEW

This Agreement is subject to review on request by the ACC or the Winnipeg Gliding Club and is in effect from April 1st to December 31st each year.
